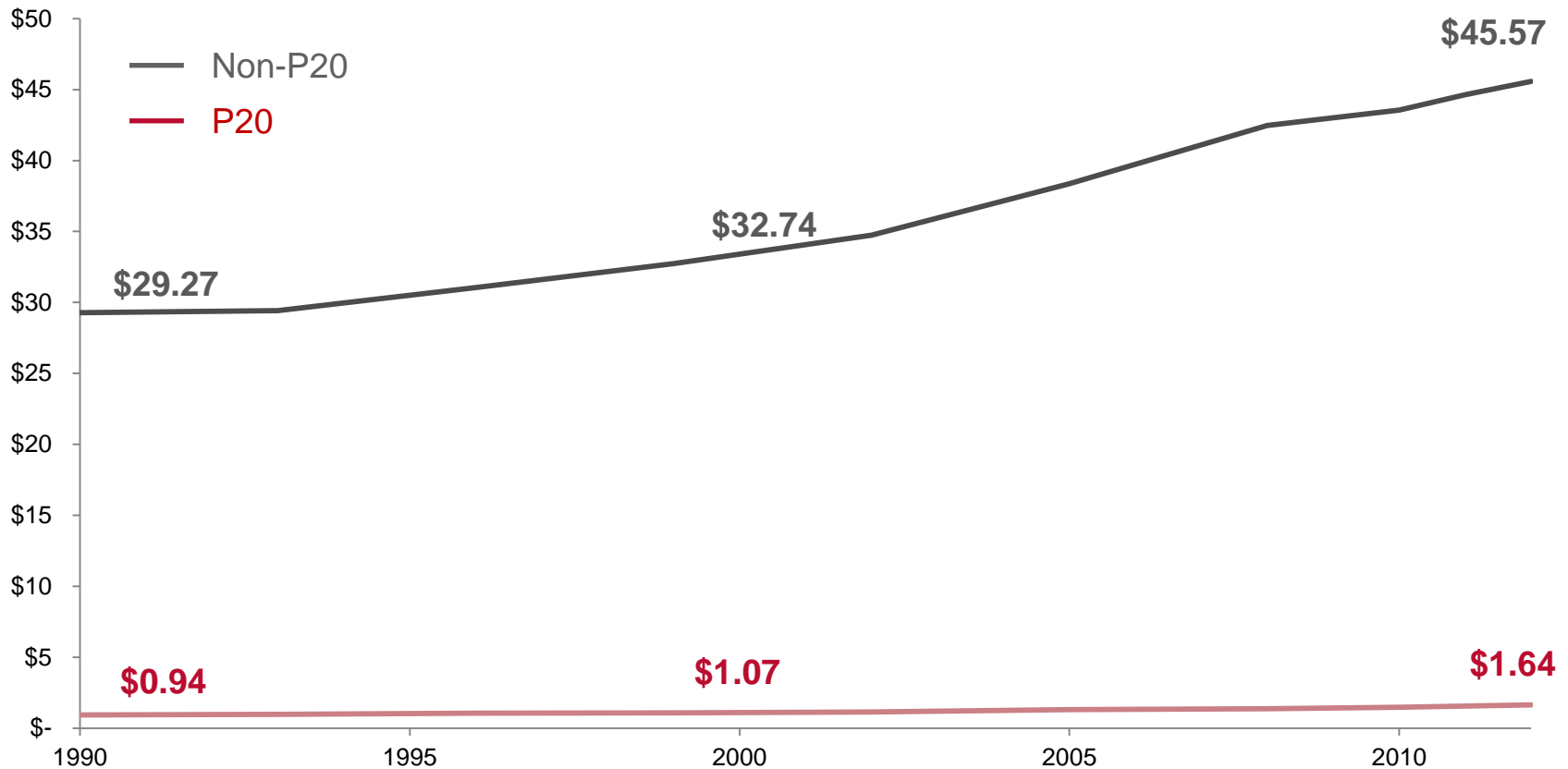

Who is being left behind?

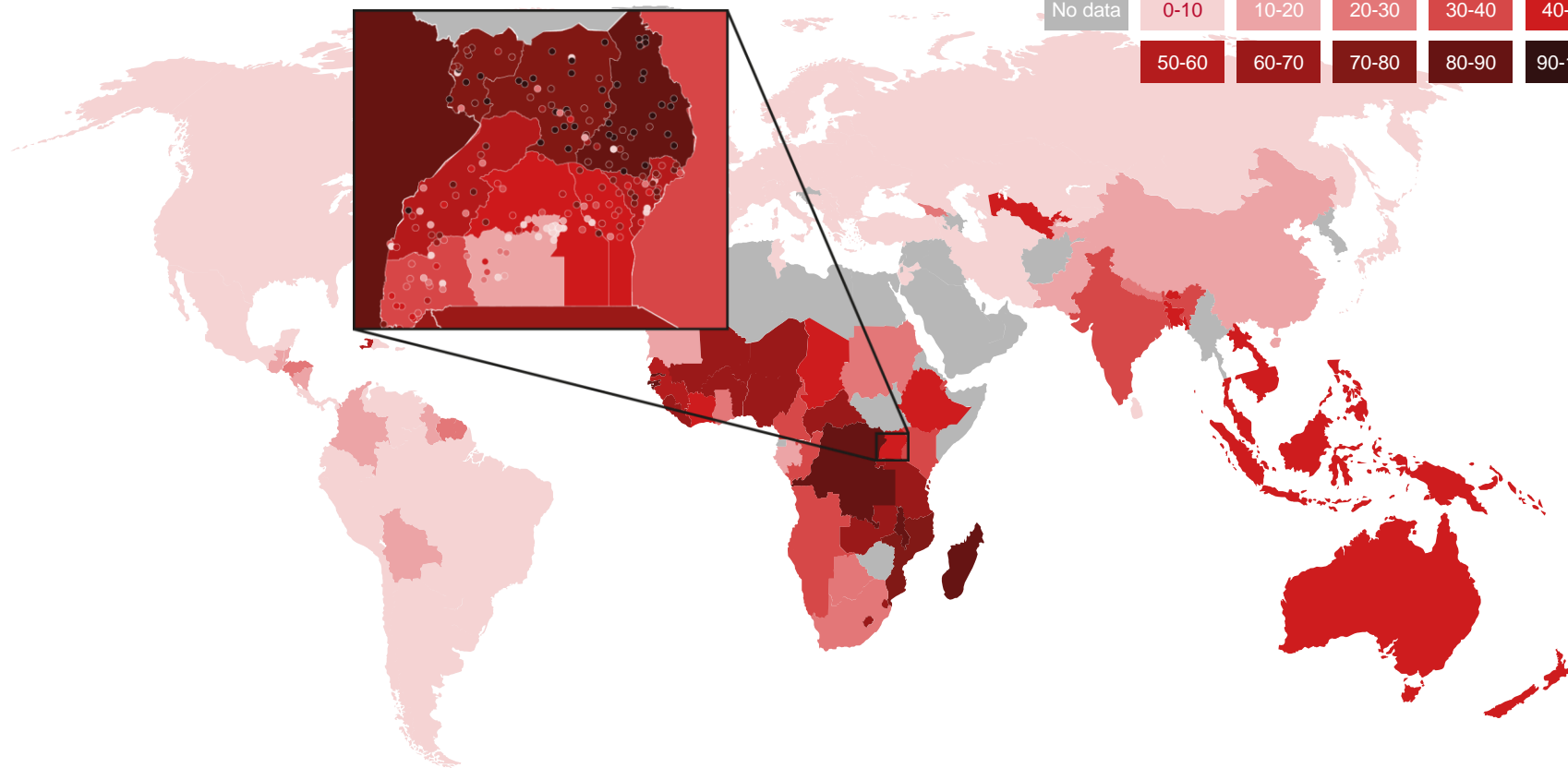
Income gap between the P20 and the rest of the world

50-60	60-70	70-80	80-90	90-100	



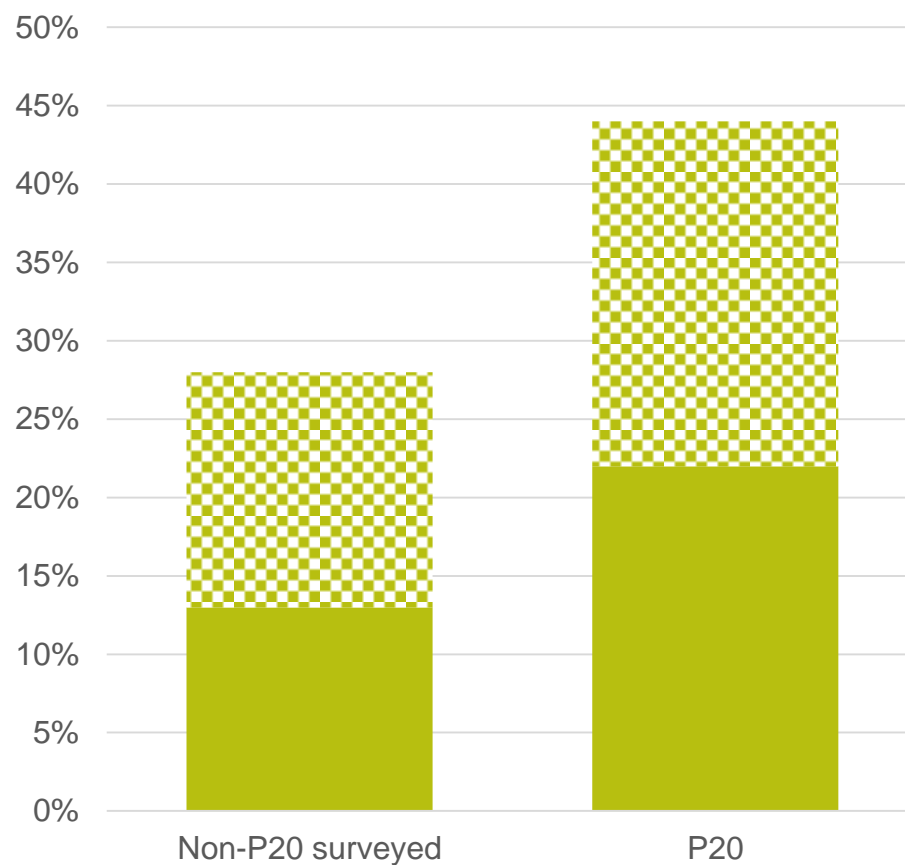
What we know about the P20

**44% of children

are stunted**

- Severely stunted



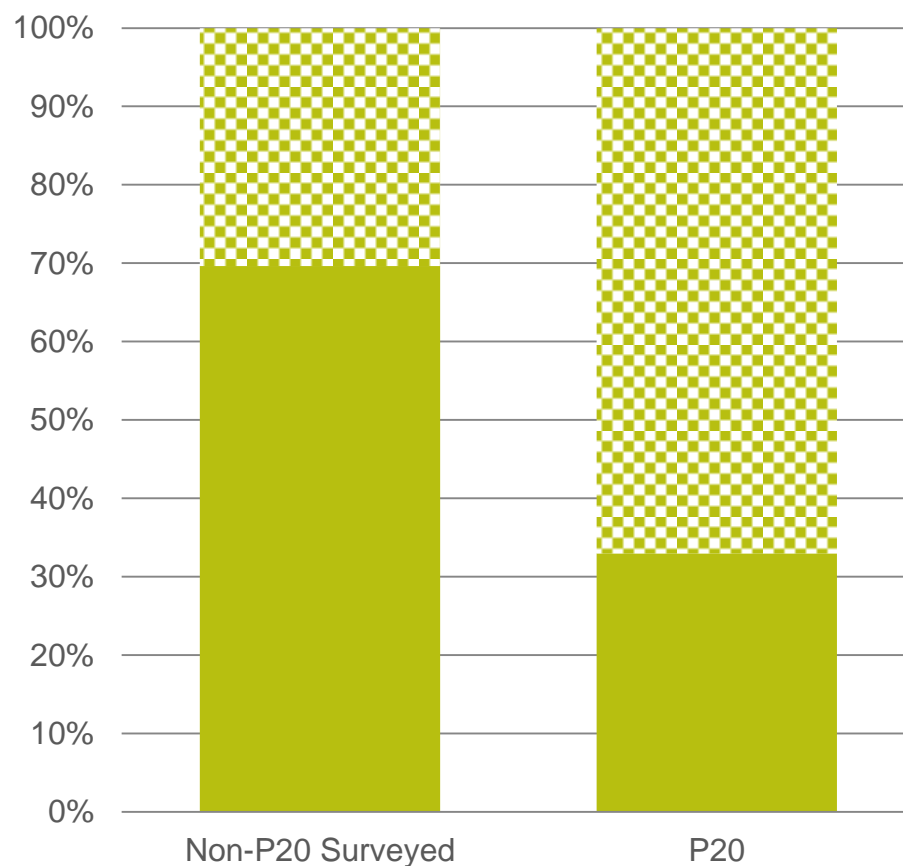
Civil registration

In the P20, only one-third of children under five had their births registered

▣ Not birth registered

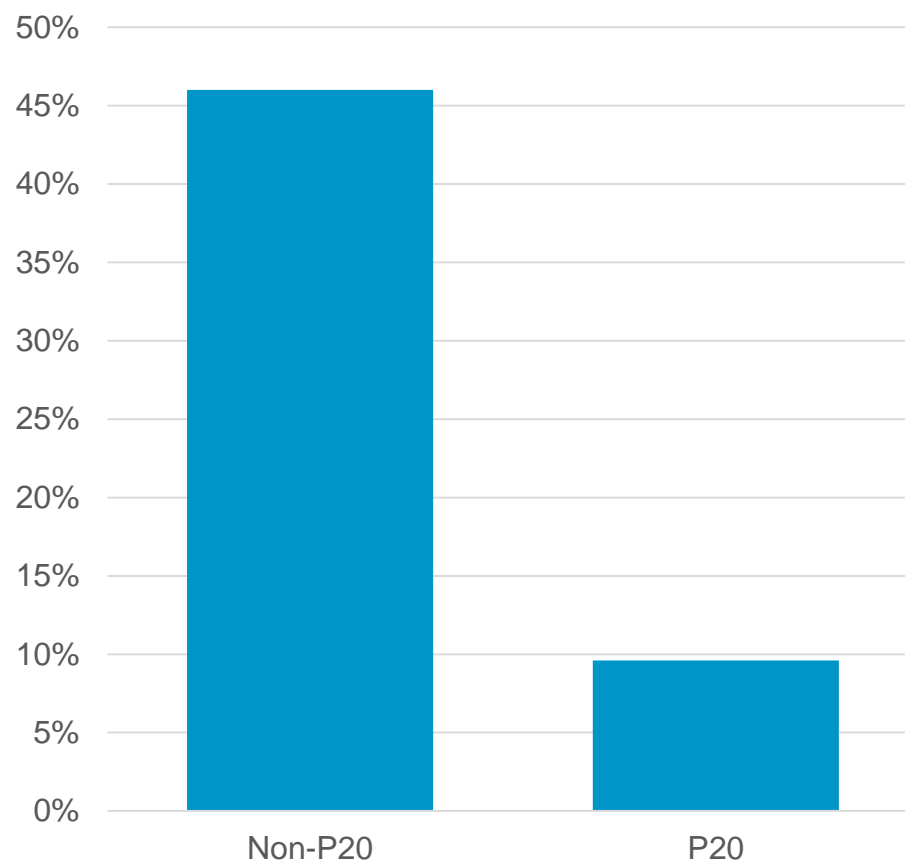
■ Birth registered

education**

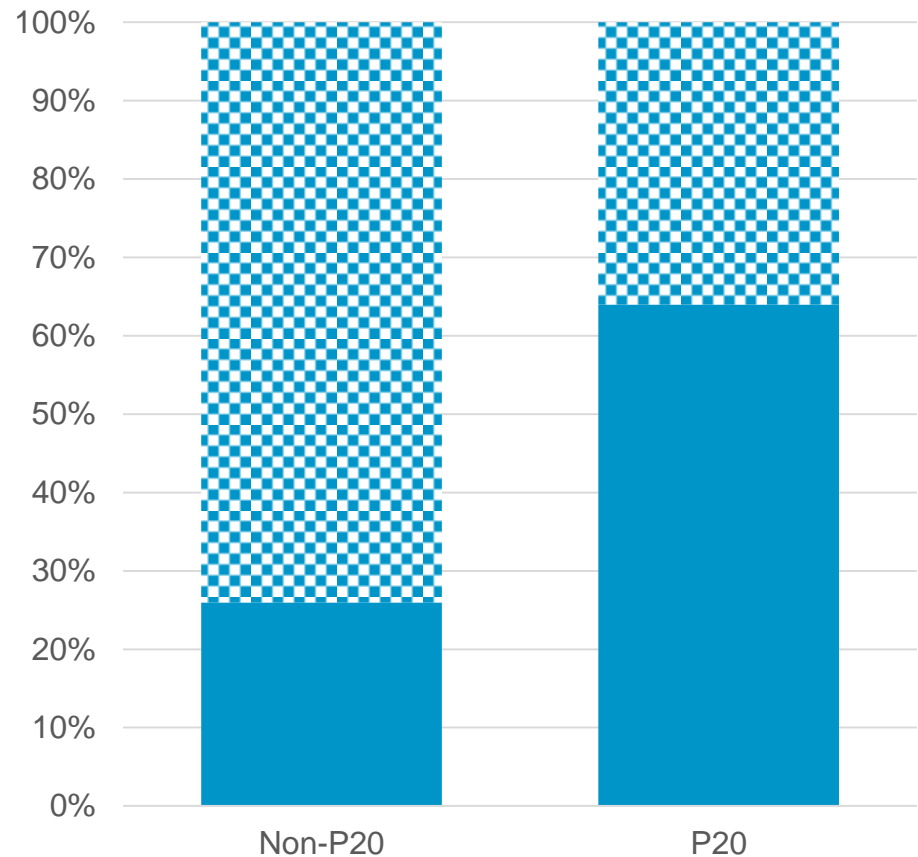


Infant and maternal mortality

Two-thirds of children in the P20 had no skilled attendant present at birth

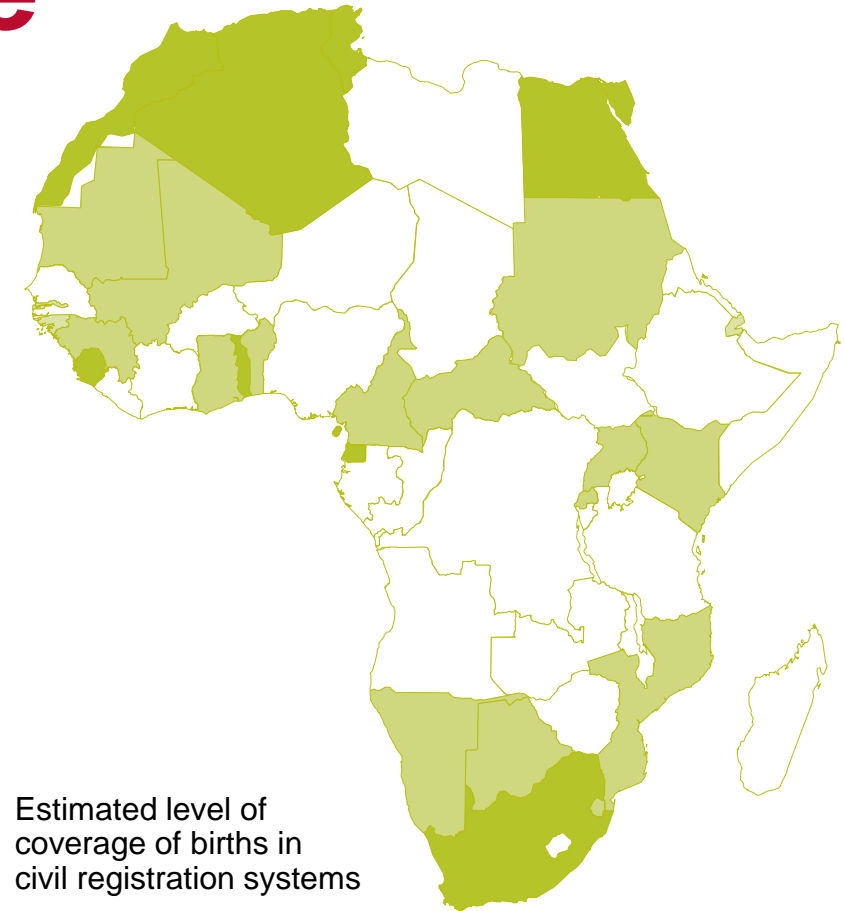
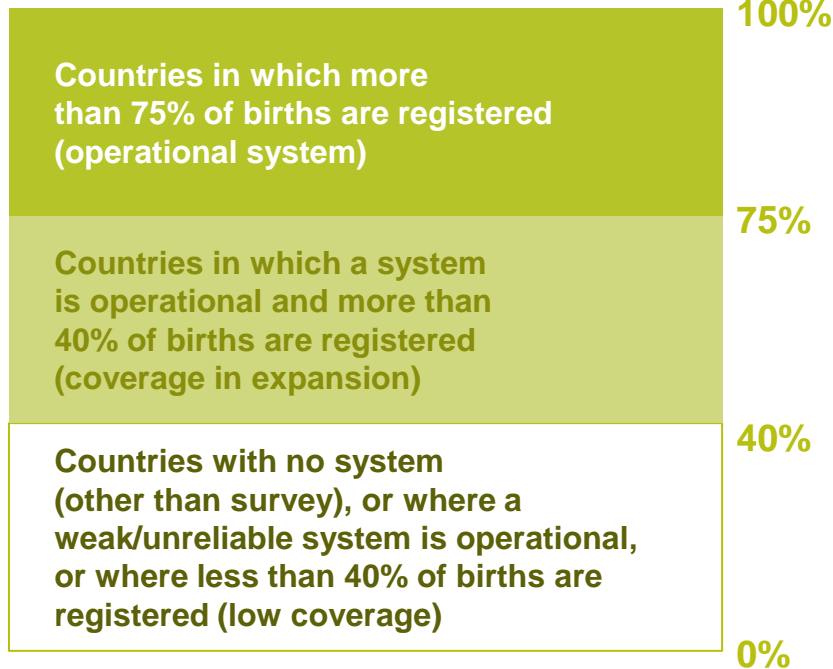
- ▣ Had skilled birth attendant

Includes all births for children under 5 years

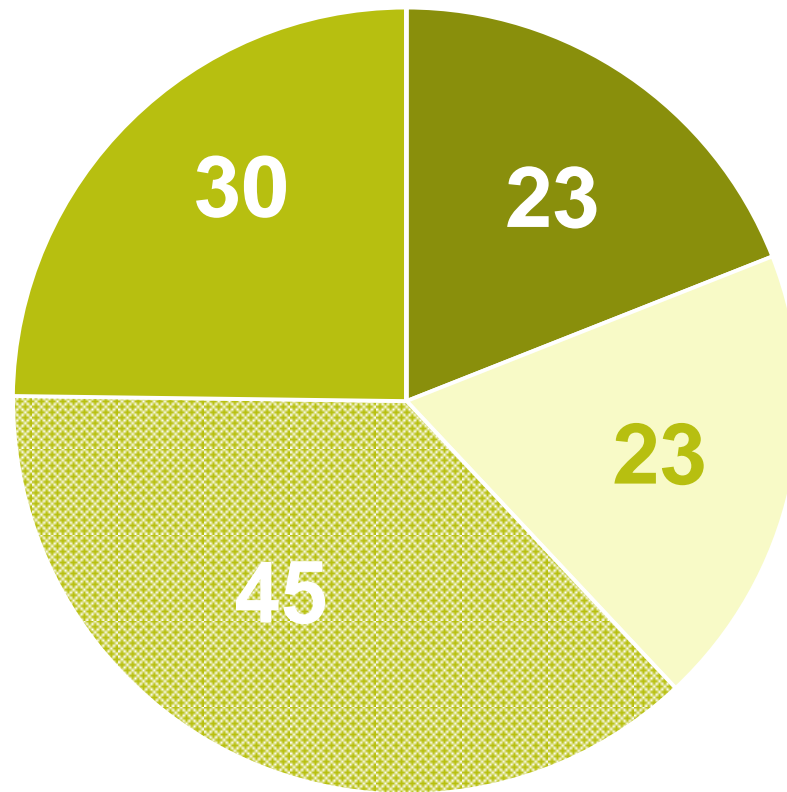


**For the poorest people to be
